This Privacy Policy will help you to understand how we collect, use and safeguard information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our Site and our Products. We will update this Privacy Policy as necessary in light of new technologies, business practices and our User's needs. This Privacy Policy applies to this Site and our Products and governs data collection and use at this Site and our Products.

Consent

CTI has a banner on the Site to let you know we use cookies and to obtain your consent. We hope you will click "Accept," but we will rely for consent on your browser settings if they are set to accept cookies when you continue to use the Site. A "Revoke" option is available to revoke consent.

When and what information we collect

We collect personal Information from you when you fill out a form or download a document. When ordering or registering on our Site, as appropriate, we may ask you to enter your name, e-mail address, phone number or postal address. You may, however, visit our site anonymously. We may also collect information contained in any e-mail or other communication you send to us or information you give to us in any other way, as well as information required for the payment for Products that you order from us, including credit card numbers, security codes and other financial information. We may collect certain tracking information consistent with Google Analytics for internal tracking. All of this is "Personal Information." We do not sell or rent Personal Information to anyone. Except as otherwise provided in this Privacy Policy, we strive to keep your Personal Information private and will not share it with third parties.

As you use our Site or Products, we may also collect certain passive information, including your Internet Protocol address, browser type, and operating system. We also use cookies, web beacons and navigational data like Uniform Resource Locators (URL) to gather information regarding the date and time of your visit and the solutions and information you searched and viewed. We collect this type of information to make our Site and Products more useful to you. We do not deem this information as Personal Information.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include cookies, flash cookies, and/or web beacons, described below:

Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. What we use your information for
